2021 LSF Tournament | June 12,13 & 14

The LSF Executive have met several times via Zoom, and most of us met recently, face to face at Milang and the following decisions have been made with regard to Jerilderie 2021.

- This year's event will be held on Saturday 12th, Sunday 13th and Monday 14th June
- Three events will be flown over the 3 days
 - F5J
 - Australian Open Thermal
 - E-RES using the AEFA rules
- Pilots can enter 1, 2 or 3 events if they wish
- 3 person teams
- The contest format will be (subject to entry numbers) 3 heats of E-RES followed by 3 heats of F5J, followed by 3 heats of Open Thermal, then back to E-RES, F5J, OT and so on throughout the day
- Subject to good weather and a mid afternoon finish on Monday, we believe that we can fly 12 + rounds of each event
- There will be no on-field catering, so please bring supplies with you or hit the Bakery or the Truck Stop Roadhouse early each morning
- The Saturday Night dinner will almost certainly be held at the Chinese Restaurant at the Golf Club
- The Open Thermal event will be a Team Trial for the possible 2022 World F3J Championships (Covid has seriously messed up WC scheduling)
- The Grand Champion trophy will be awarded based on the addition of normalised F5J and Open Thermal scores
- The Entry Form should be available by mid-April 😊
