The selections for Argentina in March were based on the preliminary rounds from Milang, Jerilderie and Armidale. The Monday 15min flyoffs split the field into 3 groups, with the first 9 competing for the event, while the B and C groups flew for the fun of it.

Nick Chabrel flew well for two days but his high risk strategy in the Monday 4 round flyoff meant he dropped a flight. Dan Haskell lead the selection series after earlier two rounds but had a bad Sunday, and missed selection. He had a consolation Monday to finish 3rd in flyoffs.
